The cost of entry is £250* per competitor; the cost of entry covers contest fee, competitors pack & commemorative shirt, event breakfast & awards party, the Day Rod fee on the River Test & the services of a Fishing Guide. Please note that each competitor will be accompanied for the day by a designated Fishing Guide who will know the beat & perform the usual services expected of the Guide. In addition the Guide will act as referee & scorer/fish measurer for the competitor.

*Just a word on the entry fee: this event is being run on a not-for-profit basis. The entry fees will be used to pay for the costs of the contest, which includes a payment to the Guides for working both on the event day & a briefing day in early April. Any surplus will be either donated to an appropriate fishing charity or held over for the 2009 contest.

Entry is open to all comers, the only restriction being that just one member of a team may be a professional full-time or part-time fresh or saltwater fly fishing instructor or guide. A professional is defined as anyone who, within the last 3 years, has received income for services performed as a fly fisher.

A copy of the rules is attached in a further document RTOF 2008 rules. Contestants will be expected to provide all their own equipment, tackle & flies. Some beats will require wading; contestants drawn on wading beats will be advised in advance. The Guides will provide the measurement gutter. Lunch will be taken on the river, so please bring your own food & drink.

There will be an official photographer covering the event. Results & photographs will be posted on our web site after the competition. It is possible that Sky will be recording a 1 hour TV special for later transmission, so be warned if you are camera shy!

There are plenty of places to stay in & around Stockbridge. The Grosvenor Hotel, Three Cups, White Hart, Vine Inn, The Greyhound & The Peat Spade. You will find details of them and others via the Accommodation Guide at www.fishingbreaks.co.uk
